JR. & ADULT COLOR BELTS

Color belts will be called to the Staging Area by Age then BELT COLOR. We will then divide them into rings. Once the competitors are divided we will let you know what ring they will compete in.

A FEW NOTES FOR PARENTS

- We ask that you remain outside of the Staging area as it can get crowded. Also please hold on to your child's sparring bag until they are in the ring.
- All students should arrive at the Staging Area with Competitor Card in Hand. We will then Check the Cards for Novice or Competitive. We will also be checking to make sure the waiver is signed. Competitor cards for in region can be found at Competitor Card Boxes (look for your State, Instructor/City. Then find /take the students competitor card and replace folder back in bin)
- As soon as we have a ring number we will take students to the rings and announce to Parents the Ring Number so they may follow us or go ahead to the ring. Please do not stop tournament staff to ask what ring number as this just makes the process go longer. As soon as they have a ring number you and the students will be the first to know.
- All Tournament Staff & Judges are Volunteers and do their best to make this a great experience for Students and spectators.
- Please take a moment to recognize a Judge that has done an exceptional job by filling out a ballot and placing it in the ballot box at the Pro Shop. We like to acknowledge the judges that are outstanding and this helps us run better tournaments. Judges are also competing for a yearly award as top Judge.
- If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask any Black Belt you see. They all have been beginners at one point and are happy to help.
